FIRST liaison statement to ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 27/WG3

Re: ISO/IEC 4rd WD 29147

Dear Ms. Passia,

I will not be able to attend the upcoming meeting in Malaka. At the meeting FIRST will be represented by Ms. Katie Moussouris from Microsoft/US unless indicated otherwise.

While FIRST is still pleased with the direction the ISO29147 is heading we, unfortunately, have to repeat the same comments we gave for the 3rd draft which is that we are concern by the pace of its progress. The document is now in its 4rd draft but its structure is not as solid as one would expect and it still contains certain elements that have been agreed to be modified since its 1st draft. After all this time the document still feels incomplete and wanting.

Additional comment is that it would be beneficial if expected finder's behaviour can be made more explicit. Currently, throughout the document suggestions are given on what is expected from finders. We feel that summarizing these suggestions in a single place, e.g. an appendix, and making them more obvious, would improve the document.
