Education Advisory Board

FIRST has identified education as one of the pillars to deliver value to its members and to grow the global CERT community. However, education is more than just providing training sessions. FIRST is committed to building up a long term sustainable education program. It thus solicits the know-how of established experts from the global community to an educational advisory board. The educational advisory board (EAB) defines the program as described below and shall report periodically to the FIRST Board through a liaison board member.

Deliverables:

- Two service frameworks, one each for CSIRTs and PSIRTs respectively, describing the services areas and services, such an entity broadly would draft and publish.
- A guide on how to use the Services Frameworks.

Stakeholders:

The EAB, together with the FIRST board, ensures that the wider community is given the opportunity to provide feedback allowing a wider acceptance of the frameworks.

Timeline:

The chair provides a timeline for the EABs activities to the FIRST Board.

Reporting:

The chair reports on the EAB periodically.

Constitution:

The education advisory board is constituted of a chair and at least one co-chair as well as at least three voting members. The chair is appointed by the FIRST Board and must be from a FIRST member team or an associate member of FIRST. The co-chair must be approved by the FIRST board. Membership is open to all including FIRST members and Non-Members. The co-chairs and FIRST Board can allow non-members participate on the board.

Revision

The Services Frameworks shall be reviewed every three years. The FIRST Board will initiate the review process and call the ADB to live again possibly with a different membership.
