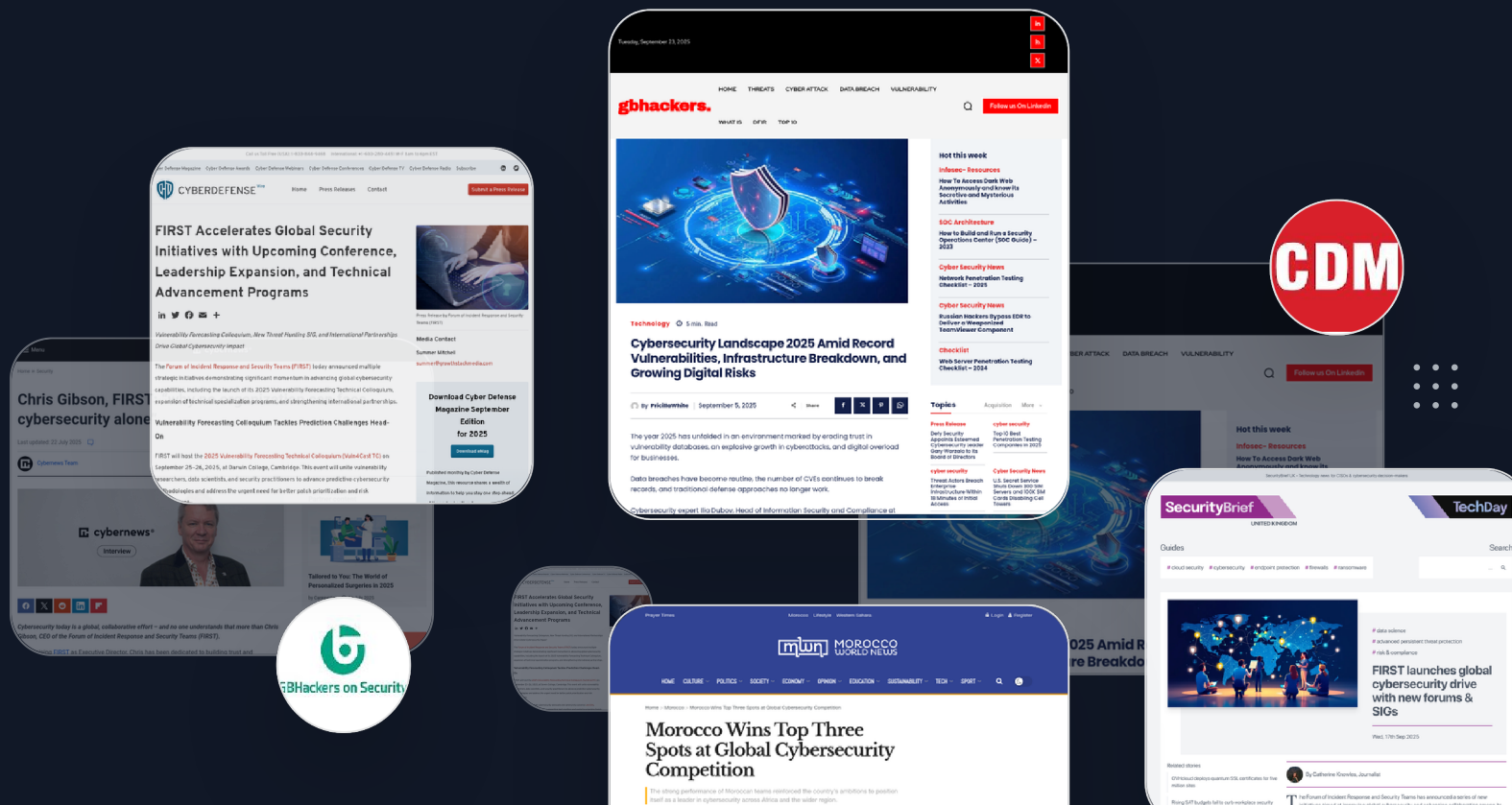

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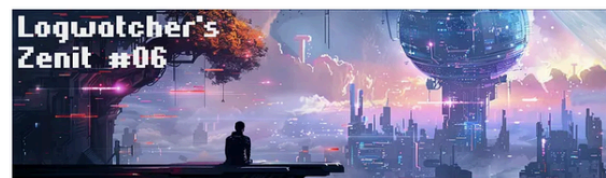

AI tool predicts 17% increase in CVE disclosures in 2025

CVE disclosures are projected to hit a record-breaking 46,886 by the end of 2025, according to a new open-source machine learning tool called [CVEForecast](#).

CVEForecast leverages historical and current [CVE data](#) from the CVE Project Official Repository and more than two dozen time series models to make its predictions. Overall, the models are trained on a dataset of more than 285,000 published CVEs from 1999 to 2025.

The tool was created by RogoLabs Founder Jerry Gamblin as a "passion project" and officially published on Monday, with a visual web dashboard and open-source [GitHub repository](#) publicly available.

"My main hope is that it simply brings awareness to the sheer, exponential growth of CVEs. Those of us in the vulnerability intelligence field have felt the pace accelerating for years, and I wanted to create a very clear, data-driven

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Cybersecurity today is a global, collaborative effort – and no one understands that more than Chris Gibson, CEO of the Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST).

Since joining FIRST as Executive Director, Chris has been dedicated to building trust and strengthening real-time cooperation. His experience spans the early days of incident response, leading critical national teams, and guiding an international nonprofit that shapes best practices for the world's cybersecurity community.

In this interview, Chris explains how FIRST supports incident responders, the risks organizations face without a sound strategy, and why cross-border collaboration and continuous learning are key to staying secure in today's dynamic threat landscape.

How did FIRST originate? What has your journey been like since your arrival?

What began as an informal collaboration among US-based response teams in 1990 quickly evolved into a formal, global community, incorporated in 1995. Today, the Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST) represents more than 800 member teams across 113 countries, all united by a shared mission: to make the internet safer for everyone.

My personal journey with FIRST began in 2001 while working at Citibank's Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT), where I had global forensic. Later, I had the opportunity to build and lead

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SEI Fellow, Founding CERT/CC Director Richard D. Pethia Inducted into FIRST Incident Response Hall of Fame

July 31, 2025—The Forum of Incident Response and Security Teams (FIRST) recently **announced** the induction of Richard D. Pethia into its prestigious Incident Response Hall of Fame at the global cybersecurity conference FIRSTCON25, held in Copenhagen, Denmark.

In the aftermath of the Morris Worm attack, the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) asked the SEI to establish an incident response capability. In 1988 Pethia founded the CERT Coordination Center (CERT/CC) as the first computer emergency response team. The center played a vital role in establishing computer security incident response teams (CSIRTs) in countries around the world, including Australia, Japan, and Qatar, among others. The CERT/CC also partnered with the Department of Homeland Security to stand up US-CERT, now part of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency.

The CERT/CC became a founding member of FIRST, the premier organization for incident response teams. Pethia's influence during the forum's early days helped

La seguridad de la información se ha convertido en uno de los pilares más críticos para el funcionamiento de organizaciones, empresas e instituciones gubernamentales. 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Risky Bulletin: HTTP2 flaw enables massive DDoS attacks

A new vulnerability in the HTTP/2 protocol can allow threat actors to launch nearly unlimited DDoS attacks to exhaust memory and crash servers.

The new attack is named **MadeYouReset**, was discovered by researchers at Deepness Lab, and is a variation of a previous attack known as HTTP/2 Rapid Reset.

The Rapid Reset attack was discovered in October 2023 after it was used to launch some of the largest DDoS attacks seen that year ([Google](#), [Amazon](#), and [Cloudflare](#)).

Both MadeYouReset and Rapid Reset target a design feature of the HTTP/2 protocol that allows a remote client (user) to connect to a server and open up to 100 connection streams to send and receive data.

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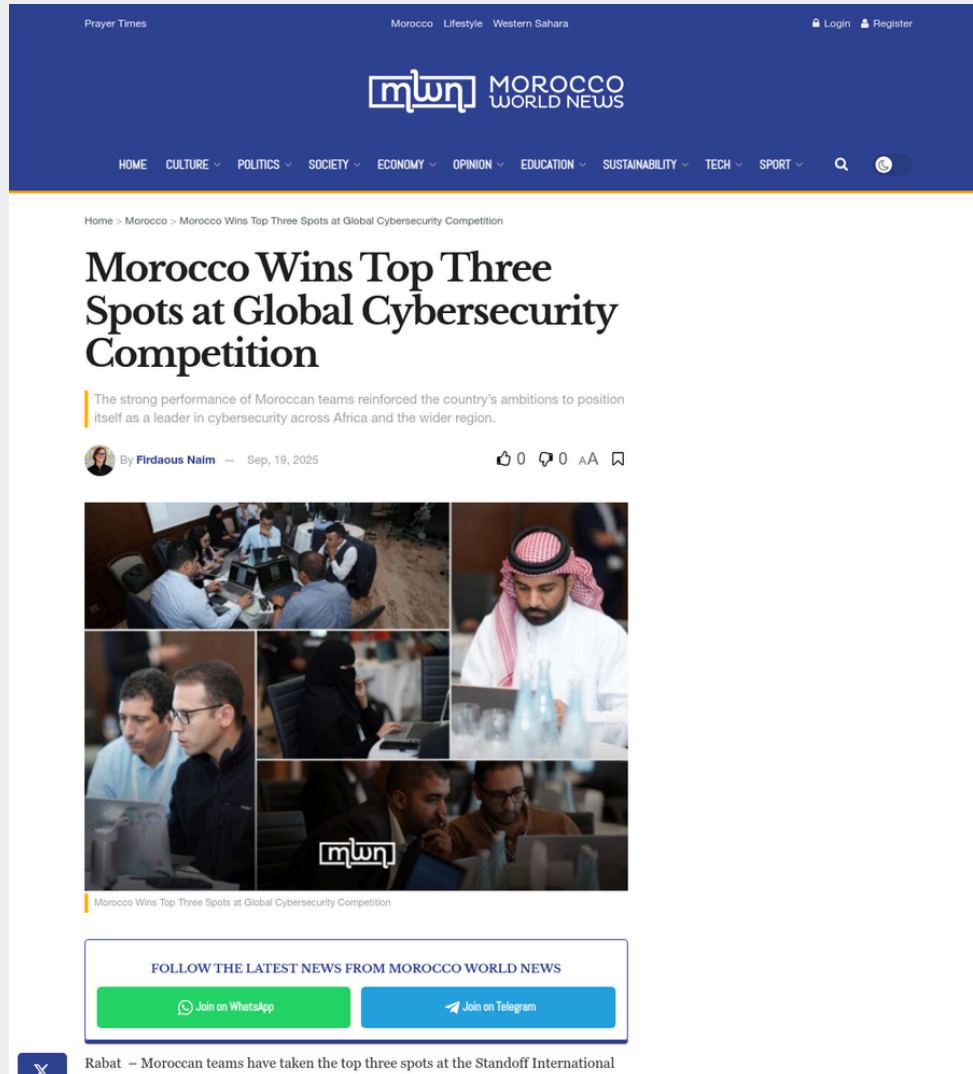
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
